Woodhouse car park	Remains free with current arrangements in place
Joseph's Well	Current arrangement remains in place - but cannot guarantee spaces
Leeds University	Current arrangement remains in place - but cannot guarantee spaces
Trust car parks	Remain free
Merrion Centre and Thackray Museum car parks	No longer available for free to NHS staff
From 1 JULY to 31 JULY 2020	
Trust car parks	<p>Will remain free until 31 July 2020 with restrictions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The barriers to Trust <u>surface car parks will be lowered and entry</u> will be via usual access arrangements with a permit The barriers to the <u>multi storey car parks will be left in the open position</u> to assist those without permits and patients and visitors.
Great George Street car park, LGI	Will be considered a barriered car park and will only be available to permit holders.
Woodhouse car park	From the 4 July - car parking will remain free for "frontline COVID NHS Staff" and access will be with a specific permit. The permit currently in use will not be valid after 4 July. More information about how this will be managed will be announced in the next day or so after we discuss the details with Leeds City Council.
Leeds City Council on street parking	Free for two hours but Leeds City Council advises NHS staff not to use unless paying after the two hours or it could attract a ticket.
Joseph's Well and the University	We are awaiting a final decision on as to whether they will extend any arrangements. An announcement is expected later this week so please check the Bulletin.
Dolly Lane/Gledhow Road car park	We're in discussions with the owners of this private car park at the back of SJUH about having a reduced daily rate of £2 per day for NHS staff during July and August 2020. More information will be shared in the Bulletin.
