Eye protection: are you using re-usable eye protection?

If yes, please see below for care and management

To ensure all staff are protected and safe, they should be using eye protection for:

- Care of patient within 2 metres
- Aerosol generating procedures
- Risk of splash to the face area.

For hygiene purposes, once issued with eye protection: if visor/ goggles are reusable, each individual can

- keep that eye protection and
- be responsible for its safe cleaning and storage



When doffing PPE, remove aprons and gloves and wash hands. Replace apron and gloves and remove eye protection

Wipes: Isopropyl alcohol All surfaces of the eye protection should be cleaned with a suitable cleansing wipe (not Chlor-clean)

The wipe must be capable of inactivating viruses (including the Covid-19 virus).

Each area will be supplied with suitable wipes

Doffing completion & Hand washing

Complete doffing:
Remove apron/gown and gloves
Wash hands
Remove mask
Wash hands
