### Action Card:

#### Receiving a patient arriving in via YAS with suspected or confirmed High Consequence Infectious Disease (HCID) Airborne or VHF

##### Patient's brought in by YAS

- YAS call clinical team with ETA
- Clinical team confirm ETA
- Security team NOT routinely requested to attend.
- YAS call clinical team on arrival and wait in ambulance
- YAS to confirm clinical case with clinical team and decide if patient needs direct admission to ward or if patient can be assessed in ambulance with a view to sending them home.

*If security officers are asked to attend  
Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is only required to be worn whilst within 2 metres (or 7 Feet) of the patient.  
Security Officers are expected to maintain a safe distance of 2 metres from the patient,  
PPE will not be required by security officers.*

*The Security Officers will act as traffic control only if required (not routine) whilst YAS ambulance remains on level 1 outside pharmacy entrance at back of GLedhow*
