Dear users of Leeds Genetics Laboratory services,

Following the launch of NHS England's Genomic Medicine Service in October 2018, Leeds Genetics Laboratory and the Yorkshire Regional Genetics Service have joined with the genetics services at the Newcastle upon Tyne Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, Sheffield Children's NHS Foundation Trust, and Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust to form the **Yorkshire and North East Genomic Laboratory Hub (Y&NE GLH)**. This laboratory and clinical partnership will provide genetics and genomics services to NHS users in Yorkshire, Cumbria and the North-East of England.

The central processing laboratory for next-generation sequencing, whole genome sequencing and other genomic services is now located at St James's University Hospital in Leeds.

The laboratory name, and the address for all genetics samples previously sent to the Leeds Genetics Laboratory has therefore changed; from the 15th of July 2019, please direct all samples to:
