How LTHT Research and Innovation can support you

Research Idea

We can assist you and your research team with the development of your research proposal. We can discuss your idea, review your application for eligibility and remit and signpost you to key sources of support,

Identify Funding

The R&I department can assist you to identify potential research calls and career development schemes available. If you would like support with identifying potential funding opportunities, please contact the R&I department during the initial stages of developing your research idea, who can horizon scan and give you information about different funding opportunities.

Funding Application

The LTHT R&I department can guide you through the research funding application process, from the point of identifying funding, to the submission of your grant application. We can guide you with eligibility, remit, key submission dates and more.

Obtaining Funding

Some funding bodies have a two stage or a preliminary outline process prior to the full submission of your application. The LTHT R&I department can assist you to understand the details and requirements of the submission process, including costings, outlining the proposed research and other key aspects of the scheme or programme you are applying to. We can also signpost you to key sources of support when developing your application.

Research Governance

After you have obtained funding, the LTHT R&I department have a dedicated team who can support you through the research approval process, including sponsorship, Research Ethics Committee and Health Research Authority Approval and obtaining research passports.

The Contract

When you have successfully obtained funding, before the funding can begin, it is the responsibility of an appointed Research and Innovation Manager within the LTHT R&I department to sign off the final contract for your funding. The R&I finance department will support you to negotiate and manage the finances of the grant.

Reporting

During the lifetime of the grant, it is a requirement of the funding body or charity that you report to them on the progress of the grant especially the research and the finances. The LTHT R&I department can signpost you to the finance department when this information is required. It is also your responsibility to update EDGE on a regular basis, to enable you to track your project and recruitment status and for us to report on our progress to funders.
