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CLEW Updates

Every 6 months the iSTAT will require a CLEW software update. This normally happens every May and November.

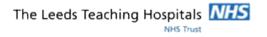
The analyser will give a warning TWO WEEKS before CLEW expiry. The POCT team will arrange for the CLEW update to be performed.

Value Assignment Sheets

Quality Control results shoud fall within an set range to ensure the analyser is performing as expected. The QC ranges change with each new batch of reagent or cartridge. To find the correct Value Assignment Sheet:-

- The sheets can be found at <u>www.abbottpointofcare.com</u> - Support - i-STAT 1 VAS
- Select your current CLEW from the drop down box
- Select your QC material and correct level
- If there are several lot numbers, make sure you select the current cartridge lot you are using
- Print out the Value Assignment Sheet and store with your ISTAT System
- Use these target values to ensure your QC result is within the expected range.

PLEASE - check you are using the correct Value Assignment Sheet each time you run a QC



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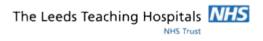
